MAINTENANCE

Home Depot Grant – Team Depot was here in January. They painted the planters, cement lattice and BBQ pits, added mulch to the planters and installed new barn doors to the main hall. Gabe made lunch for the volunteers.

Rebuilding Together – Floors & More adopted the Vets Hall as their project this year. Their volunteers will be here on Saturday, March 18. Work includes adding a grab bar in men's restroom, replacing shingles on BBQ roof, replacing 3 LED light fixtures, replacing outside sconces, painting previously damaged ceiling and sealing the floor in bar, repair planter box in front, adding fence between building and new parking lot, painting wall behind BBQ, relace molding at flags, new window screens, repair/replace locking mechanism on French doors and possibly adding bistro lights outside and lighting to display cases, Gabe will BBQ food for volunteers.

Broken Window – A man was caught on video throwing a rock through the front window, next to the entry doors, on Sunday, Jan. 29, 2023. Staff closed off the hole and cleaned up the mess. A police report was filed. Cline Glass replaced the window about 10 days after. Staff discovered this morning that the front bar window has been broken, either by a bird flying into it or a rock. Only one pane of the double pane window is cracked. Staff will work to get it replaced.

In-House Maintenance – Jesse has been busy with basic maintenance around the hall including tightening faucets in the bathroom, installing snack shelf in the bar, repairing the office ceiling, finishing the details on the new barn doors, installing slip resistant strips to Eigleberry entrance, and cleaning gutters.

Pantry – Michael Scalmanini is no longer maintaining the Vets Pantry. We will no longer be purchasing items to stocking and will rely on donations from Vince Saso. Staff will maintain the pantry.

GENERAL

Gilroy Boundaries – The City of Gilroy is applying to expand its urban service area. If LAFCO approves the expansion it could mean additional tax dollars for the District. At this time it is uncertain how much that would be.

Trash/Recycling – The new California law SB1383 requires all businesses to recycle and collect organic services starting in 2024. Staff has met with Recology to discuss the requirements. Recology isn't certain what the state will require. However, staff is taking a proactive approach and involving the janitorial service and supply company, as well as like businesses, to work with Recology to develop policies and procedures. A town meeting is being planned for April.
