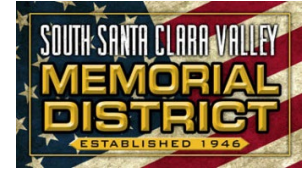

## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF BOARD VACANCY South Santa Clara Valley Memorial District**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the South Santa Clara Valley Memorial District (SSCVMD) has two vacancies on its five-member Board of Directors. One of the vacant seats is designated for a Veteran. Per California Government Code 1780, the SSCVMD Board has 60 days to appoint a new director or call for a special election. These terms for these vacant seats will expire December 2030.

At the June 15, 2026 Board of Directors meeting, the SSCVMD Board voted to use the appointment method for filling the vacancy.

### Background

SSCVMD was established as an independent special district on August 26, 1946, to recognize and serve the veterans of Gilroy and the South Santa Clara Valley.

The District is responsible for maintaining the Gilroy Veterans Hall, ensuring it remains a place where veterans, community organizations, and local residents can gather. The District is governed by a five-member Board of Directors, with at least three of the five directors required to be veterans. Directors are elected to four-year terms, and there are no term limits.

### Appointment Process

Individuals interested in being appointed to the SSCVMD Board of Directors need to fill out an application/questionnaire. Copies of the application/questionnaire can be obtained by contacting the Executive Director.

**Applications/Questionnaire Due Date: No later than 1:00 p.m. August 7, 2026.**

Applications/questionnaires received late will not be accepted.
